

Since we are a 501c3, non-profit organization, we can legally accept boats as donations and provide the donor a receipt that can be used for tax purposes. While Sea Scouts can certainly receive donations they cannot provide a legal receipt. This is where NLPS would come in.. We are considering a partnership that would allow us limited use of the vessel while Sea Scouts would operate and maintain it, and, of course, use it for teaching seamanship skills.

Before the Squadron does this, we would like to get the pulse of the Squadron on such an endeavor. Do you think that NLPS should take on the responsibility of a donated boat? Maybe it should be a boat that we could race on Wednesday nights or periodically in other weekend races. We could use it as an ambassador on the water—with a banner telling about the Squadron. Hopefully, it would attract new members. Also, a close association with the Sea Scouts is great because the Scouts are in need of lots of classes that taught by the Power Squadron. Associating ourselves with the Sea Scouts can be a win-win situation.

The thought is that revenue from sale of the vessel would be split with the Sea Scouts. So it could add to our coffers. However, NLPS would be the owner, so there is a potential that we would need to provide upgrades in order to eventually sell the vessel. Let me know your thoughts. 
